This month our own Julie Goettsch will tell us the story of orchids on the Orchid Isle: what orchids were here before mankind, what orchids came here next and who brought them, and the fascinating story of Vanda Miss Joaquim that was grown here by the millions.

Julie grew up in Santa Ana, CA and first came to Hawaii in 1969 as a teacher. After a stint teaching in Okinawa, Japan, she returned to Hawaii, married a submariner from Colorado, and went to Colorado with him. where she became а school principal and then



worked for IBM Global Services in Boulder, CO. Julie started growing cattleya orchids in Colorado in her living room window. 17 years ago, she retired and returned to Hawaii.

Julie says she loves Hawaii, the Orchid Isle, the town of Hakalau, her 4 Persian cats, her orchids, koi, scuba diving, macro underwater photography, her Tesla, and travel.
